RE: Temporary Yard Facilities - School Rebuild Programme (SRP)

We are pleased to update you on the progress of the School Rebuild Programme (SRP) at University Academy Long Sutton. As part of this exciting development, we are preparing to transition to temporary yard facilities to accommodate the ongoing construction work.

From Monday, 3rd February, pupils will begin using the first of two temporary yards. These arrangements are essential to ensure the smooth running of the school during this phase of the project.

Social Time Arrangements:

Year 11 pupils will use the Social Area and Quad during social times.

Year 7, 8, 9, and 10 pupils will use the temporary yard and Sports Hall during social times.

Once the second temporary yard is completed, we will provide you with further updates about any additional adjustments.

Access to Facilities:

To ensure that pupils can move safely and efficiently between lessons, the following access points will be used:

Year 11 pupils will access the Social Area and Quad using the nearest and quickest possible route to their Period 2 and Period 4 classroom.

In Year 7, 8, 9 and 10 pupils need to adhere to the following routes:

- Pupils with Period 2 or Period 4 lessons in the Tower, Music, Library, Sports Hall, or IT4 will use the double doors opposite the Music room.
- Pupils with Period 2 or Period 4 lessons in Science, Art, or IT3 will use the double doors near Science.
- ➤ Pupils with Period 2 or Period 4 lessons in IT1, IT2, IT3, the Lincoln Room, DT, or French will access these facilities via the double doors at the rear of the school.

This information will be shared with pupils in detail through assemblies, form time discussions, and day-to-day guidance from class teachers to ensure they are fully informed and confident about the new arrangements.

Queuing and entry arrangements for the canteen will remain as they are currently.
