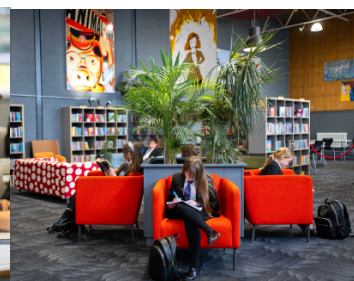

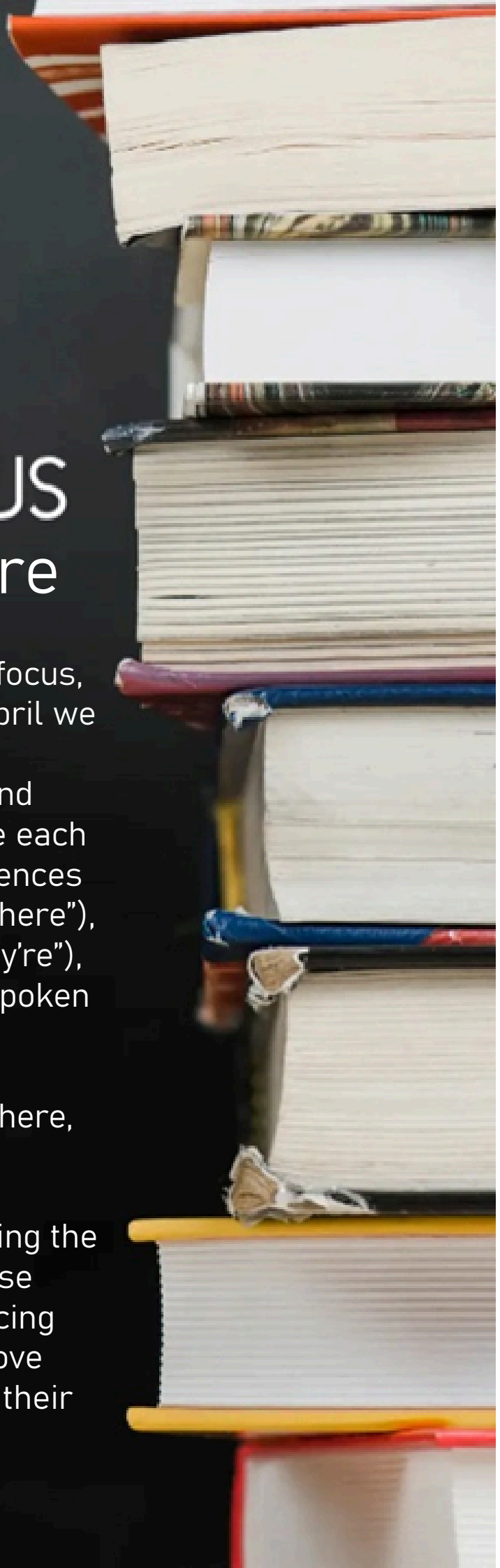
# LITERACY FOCUS

## Their, There, They're

As part of our whole-school literacy focus, the week commencing Tuesday 21st April we will focus on developing pupils' understanding of "their," "there," and "they're." Pupils will revisit how to use each form correctly, recognising the differences between possession ("their"), place ("there"), and the contraction of "they are" ("they're"), supporting greater accuracy in both spoken and written language.

For example: "Their books are over there, and they're ready to read."

This focus supports pupils in recognising the distinct meanings and uses of these commonly confused words, reinforcing correct usage and helping to improve fluency, precision, and confidence in their writing across all subjects.
