I would like to take this opportunity to invite you to The University Academy Long Sutton's Year 6 Induction Days on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> June. The days have been specially designed to let you get to know UALS and some of our staff. There will be the opportunity to meet myself, Pastoral staff and other teachers. You need to attend wearing your primary school uniform, but you will need to wear trainers for practical activities. Please remember to bring a pen and pencil to take part in activities. You will also need to bring your lunch and a drink.

The days will be split into different parts. You will meet myself, Pastoral staff and find out more about the Academy, meet your Form Tutor and attend some sample lessons. You will also get to take part in some exciting activities. The days are designed to let you find out what type of activities you can expect when you get to the UALS in September, making the move from your primary school to the UALS a little easier.

You need to arrive at the Academy by 8.45am and go straight to the Main Hall. To arrive at UALS on the days you will need to use the transport to the Academy that you will be using in September, and return home by the same means. This means that if you are planning to use the Academy bus service in September it will be permitted to use the bus for these days but your parent/carer must return the slip at the bottom of their letter to let us know or you may not be allowed on the bus. It is up to your parent/carer to organise any other transport. You will leave at 3.20pm which is the end of the Academy day.

If you have any questions regarding the Induction Days, ask your primary teacher or speak to your parent/carer who can contact the Academy and we will be happy to help. Before your Induction Days, a representative from UALS will visit your primary school to explain the transition process and answer any questions you might have.
